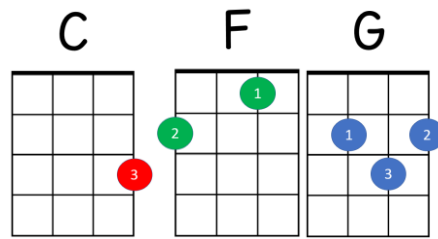


Your Name is a Song

Down deep in your heart, (G)

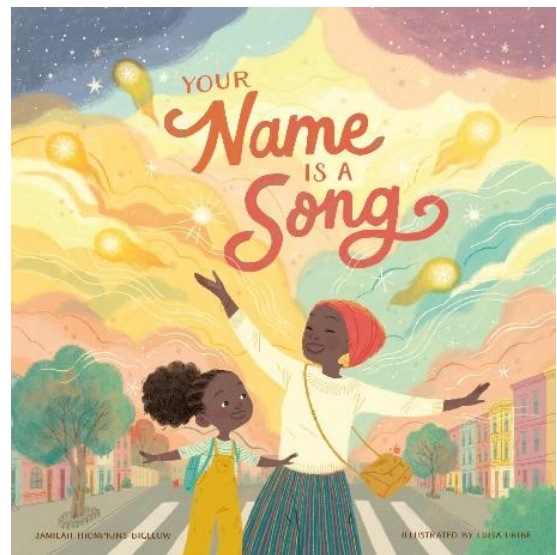
It sets you apart! (C)
